Requiriments

(for both journals)

Editorial board has laid down binding technical standards to be applied to all received manuscripts. Only articles which meet all the technical standards and receive a positive reviewers opinion will be published.

The manuscript should meet the following requirements:

1. Main body, except the title, must be written as follows:

- Font - Times New Roman
- Font style – Normal
- Size – 12 pt.
- Line spacing – 1,5
- Margins – Right: 2,5 cm, Left: 2,5 cm, Top: 2,5 cm, Bottom: 2,5 cm
- Text alignment – Justified

2. Each manuscript should be divided into three basic parts: introduction, body and conclusion.

3. There should be a header in the upper left- hand corner that includes first name, last name, institution that author represents / author workplace.

4. Title should be centered, in 14pt. Times New Roman font, bold.

5. Manuscript, including tables, chart and figures, should not be longer than 10 pages A4.

6. Headings should be in 12pt. Times New Roman, bold.

7. Tables, charts and figures:

- Each table, chart and illustrations should be numbered and titled. The source must be indicated at the bottom of the table. Table text should be in 10pt. Times New Roman font with single line spacing. Minimal table width: 8,1 cm, maximum table width: 17,1 cm. Any description of the table should be written below the source, if necessary.
- Tables, charts and illustrations must be created in either MS Word or Excel.
- Title of the chart must be indicated above the chart (no full stop at the end).

8. Tables, charts and illustrations must be black and white.

9. Citations:

- Footnotes should be located at the bottom of each page, indicated with the superscript number (Arabic numerals) in the main body of the text.
- Footnote number should be inserted before the full stop, comma or semicolon, without space.
- Footnotes should be in 10 pt. Times New Roman, with single line spacing.
- Footnote should include: author's name initial, full stop, space and author's surname, comma, space, article/ book title, comma, space, place and date of publication, comma, space, „p” (full stop), space, page number, full stop.

- If you provide a footnote for a source that was cited in the preceding footnote citing the same work use: Ibidem, p. 56.
 - If you refer to the previously cited work use: W. Anioł, op.cit., p. 27.
 - If two sources by the same author are cited indicate the title of work to clarify: W. Anioł, Europejska polityka ..., op.cit., p. 29-41.
 - Footnotes should be justified.

10. Bibliography:

- All cited authors should be listed alphabetically at the end of the paper. Technical guidelines apply to bibliography.
- Bibliography should be divided into three sections: Primary sources, Books, Main articles.

- Following format should be used regarding Internet sources:

EXAMPLE:

Powszechna Deklaracja Praw Człowieka, [Online], dostępne:
http://ms.gov.pl/prawa_czl_onz/prawa_czlow_12.doc, 06.10.2007.

- End of the each footnote should be marked with a full stop.

- Editorial board reserve the right to edit and shorten articles if necessary, along with the technical guidelines.
- Articles which do not meet the technical standards described above will not be published.
- Authors will be entitled for to one copy of the printed journal free of charge.
